.... Andrew Sockalexis, marathon runner from Old Town, Maine, was fourth in the 1912 Olympics at Stockholm, Sweden. Born in 1892, Sockalexis died at age 27 of tuberculosis. He was second cousin to Louis Sockalexis, Cleveland Indian baseball great. To the end "Soc" believed he could have won Stockholm if 'the team had not been overtrained' and he was allowed to 'run my own race. I did not get word to start my sprint until three miles from the finish, he lamented, 'and the lead secured by the two South Africans was too great to overcome. I finished in fine shape and that night attended a reception and a banquet'. Soc's time over Stockholm's 54-hill course (1) was 2:42:07. He finished second in the Boston marathon twice, in 1912 and 1913. Sockalexis was Maine's first notable runner ....

So that's Andy on our cover this month. There's a race named after him held every August in Old Town. We Rats should try to make it up there.
